## Waxhaw Celebrates 125th Anniversary of Incorporation

On Friday, March 7th the Town of Waxhaw celebrated its Quasquicentennial with an official ceremony and First Friday activities despite more than an inch of cold, heavy rain that fell on the area through 4 p.m. Mayor Gardner, Town Board Commissioners Fitzgerald, Hunt and Warner read a proclamation declaring 2014 as Waxhaw 125th anniversary and declared a year-long celebration recognizing this important milestone. Dozens of reenactors dressed in period garb to honor the Town's history. Watch for events recognizing Waxhaw's history at all major events this year.

# A Message from the Town Manager



## **Economic Development**

The buzzword everywhere is economic development. Everyone wants to see economic development in his or her community. Over the last several years, your town government has undertaken several steps to help build a strong foundation for future economic development in the town. This month, I want to share some of the things that Waxhaw is doing to promote economic development.

In 2009, the Town was selected to become part of the North Carolina Main Street program. This nationally recognized program is a national template for downtown economic development that has four components one of which is Economic Restructuring. The Economic Restructuring Committee is focusing its efforts in the downtown. Under the leadership of Don Fisher, this committee is beginning to develop an implementation plan based on previous work and research on what is needed in downtown. This research includes customer surveys, retailer self assessments, a comprehensive assessment of downtown real estate, and financial and business development opportunities. The committee will look at comprehensive demographic, lifestyle segmentation, consumer spending and business data to profile customers, analyze markets, evaluate competitors, and identify key opportunities for a successful downtown.

The Small Town Main Street Committee Promotions Committee has been very successful in working with the downtown merchants in a true partnership of collaboration between fellow merchants and the Town. One of our star aspects of that program is our First Friday events. If you have not been to First Friday, please join us. Each month has a different theme. A number of our merchants have reported increased sales during these events. Feeding off the First Friday success, the Promotions Committee's endeavor for the next fiscal year will be to promote the downtown's brand identity and develop a cohesive downtown marketing campaign to collectively market the downtown marketplace.

The Small Town Main Street Design Committee, in cooperation with the Town Beautification Committee, also continues to work to reinforce that brand identity with a wayfinding project which is underway. The wayfinding project will highlight the brand through vehicular and pedestrian signs, community gateways, community park entrances, and banners.

Another part of economic development focus involves the façade improvement program which is administered by the Town's Historic Preservation Commission. This program is downtown-focused and provides matching grant funds for building owners wishing to improve their building façade to the original look of their building. Interest in this program continues to grow and I am excited that the Board of Commissioners views this as one of its priorities.

Development of our town's parks, recreation, and cultural resources is the focus of the Town's Park and Recreation Committee that has its pulse on the master plan developed in 2012 and the Carolina Thread Trail Master Plan and its implementation within Waxhaw.

In December 2013, the Board reactivated the Waxhaw Economic Development Corporation. Led by former Mayor Pro Tem Erin Kirkpatrick, corporation members are beginning to identify and work on their areas of focus. The Waxhaw Economic Development Corporation will be focusing their efforts on economic development interests throughout the town.

Each of these committees are staffed by well-versed and respected volunteers in the community and I am sure will coordinate well together. The Town has also made significant investments in planning which should result in better economic development opportunities. The various small area plans, along with the recently approved Form Based Code in the downtown, are important. The small area plans provide a road map for the Board of Commissioners to envision the future for the affected areas. Thus, one seeking to invest in an area will have a better understanding of what is anticipated for that particular area. The Form Based Code is a more modern development code that makes development more streamlined. I am proud of everyone who contributed to the development of these plans and code. Plans are underway to update the Comprehensive Plan which was last prepared over 5 years ago. Countless hours and investment has been made in these plans which will direct the course for the Town of Waxhaw for years to come. ## Dog Licenses Required in Town Limits

Spring will soon be here and with spring brings the renewing of your current dog license. All dogs located within the corporate town limits are required to have a dog license. The current dog license will expire June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014. A new registration form will be required along with a current statement from the vet of proof of vaccination for rabies has been done. The new form will be on the town website starting May 1<sup>st</sup>, town hall or may be requested by mail. The form will have the fees for acquiring the required license. The "Animal Control" ordinance is located on the town website or a copy can be requested from Town Hall. Penalties will incur after July 1<sup>st</sup> if license is not acquired. If you have any questions please call Town Hall.

## Waxhaw Recertified as Tree City USA Community

Waxhaw Public Services recently received word from the North Carolina Forest Service of its recertification as a Tree City USA community.



The Tree City USA program is a national program that provides the framework for community forestry management for cities and towns across America. To qualify as a Tree City USA community, a town or city must meet four core standards of sound urban forestry management: 1) maintaining a tree board or department, 2) having a community tree ordinance, 3) spending at least \$2 per capita on urban forestry and 4) celebrating Arbor Day. The program was established by The Arbor Day Foundation and the National Association of State Foresters.

# Waxhaw Town Manager Announces Retirement



After seven years as the Town Manager for the Town of Waxhaw, Michael McLaurin has announced his retirement effective April 30, 2014.

McLaurin joined the Town of Waxhaw in late 2006 and brought 30 years of experience in local and regional government. During his career he worked with the Charlotte Police (civilian) and Centralina COG. While at COG, he served as Interim Manager for Stanley in 2005 and 2006. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice from Pfeiffer University has a Master's Degree in Public Administration and has completed the UNC School of Government's Municipal Administration Course as well as their Public Executive Leadership Academy. In 2013, McLaurin graduated from the Senior Executive Institute at the University of Virginia. He most recently was elected to the Board of Directors for the N.C. City County Management Association and is a published author on public sector issues. McLaurin is a Credential Manager with the International City Management Association.

McLaurin said that he has been very pleased with the progress that was made during his term as Town Manager. He credited and thanked the employees for their work and dedication to the town and its citizens. He also thanked the many volunteers who collaborate with the town on its many efforts.

Mike is credited for his effort in bringing a high level of service to the citizens of Waxhaw and leading with an attitude of integrity while helping to bring a diverse group of people together for common goals. Some accomplishments while under his watch are the preservation of the Overhead Bridge in Downtown Waxhaw and restoring the Waxhaw water tower; creating Waxhaw's own Building Inspections Division; upgrading technology throughout the town; expanding the Events and Tax Collection Divisions; setting up a Human Resources Department; strengthening internal audit controls and achieving a strong fiscal balance. Additionally, Waxhaw received the Tree City USA distinction and the Preserve America City designation; the Small Town Main Street program was implemented and has won two awards; received OSHA Gold and Silver Awards and the SHARP Award; HC Nesbit Park was completed; and a Pedestrian Plan, Comprehensive Plan, and Local Area Transportation Plan were completed. The Police Department received needed technological upgrades and implemented an Animal Control program, while the Waxhaw Cemetery was greatly improved after being placed under the leadership of the Public Services Department. The Town has implemented an aggressive capital improvement plan that include park enhancements, construction of a new police department with plans for new municipal facilities and future plans for public services facilities.

Mike will be missed by employees and citizens for his dedication to improving Waxhaw both inside and outside of Town Hall. Plans for a retirement farewell event may be announced at a later date

## Carolina Thread Trail Awards \$46,069 to Waxhaw for Parking Lot Access Point

The Carolina Thread Trail Governing Board has awarded a grant to the Town of Waxhaw in the amount of \$46,069.00 for the construction of a parking lot to access a portion of the Carolina Thread Trail. The existing gravel parking lot across from the Prescott Subdivision off of Waxhaw-Marvin Road was originally built as part of the development and recently transferred to the Town of Waxhaw's ownership.

The grant provided by the Carolina Thread Trail will provide for a new public driveway entrance, a paved parking lot, signage and handicap access to the existing half-mile paved trail that currently exists along Twelve Mile Creek. Construction is expected to be completed on the project by the end of the first quarter of 2014.

"This is an exciting project for the Town as it will provide Waxhaw with its first dedicated access to the Carolina Thread Trail System," said Greg Mahar, Director of Planning & Community Development for the Town of Waxhaw. "This is the first step in accessing the half mile of paved trails that we currently have in Waxhaw," said Mahar, "which is going to grow as the trail system connects to the Millbridge subdivision and ultimately to South Carolina along Twelve Mile Creek."

Philip Blumenthal, Chair of the Carolina Thread Trail, expressed his appreciation for the enthusiasm that the Town of Waxhaw has demonstrated for the Carolina Thread Trail. "With the energy and commitment of communities like yours," said Blumenthal, "we have much to celebrate as The Thread winds throughout our region."

The Carolina Thread Trail is a 15-county, two state initiative designed to inspire and facilitate the creation and development of a regional network of trails, blueways and conservation corridors that will link more than 2.3 million citizens. Currently 119 miles of The Thread are open to the public and continues to grow.


