# A Message from the Town Manager



Several months ago the Board of Commissioners voted to contract with the Lawrence Group and David Creech and Associates to work on two projects which will help shape the future of our downtown. The Lawrence Group will work with our board, staff and citizens to develop a downtown small area plan which will shape the future of the downtown for the next twenty years. Through this planning process potential sites for a new municipal facility will also be identified. Once a site is selected David Creech and Associates will be responsible for working with the town to design the facilities.

As you might guess, this town does a great deal of planning ranging from comprehensive plans to transportation plans and parks and recreation plans, etc. These plans help to define the future of the town and to identify areas of potential conflict and opportunities for collaboration. A good planning process also allows for a great deal of citizen involvement so that citizens and businesses can help shape the future of the community. As your Town Manager, it is very important to me, both personally and professionally, that the citizens are aware and have the opportunity to participate.

A few weeks ago, the Board of Commissioners appointed the Downtown Small Area Plan Advisory Board. This Board will work to help create the small area plan for downtown Waxhaw. Membership on this Advisory Board includes representatives from the business community, property owners, community organizations, town advisory committees and the Board of Commissioners. Appointees include Jason Loeske, Terry Settle, Jerry Myles, James Warner, Annette Nikondvich, Tim Giovanniello, Pat Kitto, Jeff Blythe, Gay Diller, Jan Emore, Jamie Leggett, and Mayor Pro-Tem Erin Kirkpatrick. The President of the Waxhaw Business Association Loyd Pennington, and Commissioner Mike Stewart will serve as alternates for their respective organizations.

On April 3, representatives from the Lawrence Group met with various downtown stakeholders to identify issues impacting downtown. An orientation for the committee members was held that evening at 6:30 p.m. at the Waxhaw Woman's Club.

**We need your involvement on April 23<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30 p.m. at the Waxhaw Woman's Club. The first public meeting to work on the plan will take place and an outline will be presented by the Lawrence Group representatives. Presentations on various development topics will be provided, followed by a hands-on design session where participants will work together to craft a vision for downtown Waxhaw.**

A public planning and design workshop, also known as a charrette, will follow. This process will begin on April 30 and will conclude on May 3 at the Waxhaw Woman's Club. A charrette is a highly interactive process in which participants provide ideas and feedback to designers to help shape a vision. The work will be performed by professionals in their field with expertise in traffic engineering, public infrastructure, utilities, housing, economic development and environmental impacts. Preliminary design work is done on-site during the charette and you are encouraged to participate as much as possible to offer your ideas. Community meetings on the process and results will be held from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Monday April 30 and Thursday May 3. Daily Project Updates/Plan Pin-up Sessions are scheduled on Tuesday, May 1 and Wednesday May 2 from 5:30 p.m. until 6:30 p.m.

I hope you will take time to participate. Your involvement helps make for a better community. Thanks for considering participating to help shape the future for our children and grandchildren. Please contact me if I can be of assistance to you.

## Our Lady of Grace Catholic Mission to build on Waxhaw Highway

Are you aware there is a Catholic congregation nearby? Our Lady of Grace Catholic Mission is presently having Mass on Thursdays at 9:30 a.m. at the Mission House, 7031 Waxhaw Highway (Route 75) and Saturdays at 4:00 p.m. at the Indian Land Recreation Center on Highway 521. Our Lady of Grace will soon be kicking off a Capital Campaign to build a church on Waxhaw Highway (Route 75) on land which was generously donated. They are now in a position to accept donations for the new church as well as registration for new parishioners. Our Lady of Grace Mission Church was established in February 2008 as a mission of St. Philip Neri. The first Mass was held in the Belair Methodist church on February 9, 2008. This church seats about 200 members. Incredibly, Our Lady of Grace's first Mass filled the tiny church with over 250 people. Our Lady of Grace has continued to grow since its inception. The number of families has nearly doubled and is expected to continually increase. This rapid growth suggests that the time has come to create their own house of worship. Through a variety of meetings and parishioner input, it has been decided that the new church will seat 650 persons, have nine multi-functional rooms, a working kitchen, support staff offices and a multi-purpose room for parish functions. In addition, there will be room for a media center/workroom, a gathering area and ample storage room. The design will house all of the above components in an upper and lower floor plan. This will allow separate entrances for the church, offices, meeting rooms, and multi-purpose room. For more information, call 803-283-4969.





# Second Chance Boutique by Turning Point Opens in Waxhaw

You might miss it while navigating your way through traffic on Providence Road, but next time you are driving past the shopping area north of downtown, home to stores like NAPA, Bojangles, Food Lion and more, look behind the CVS Pharmacy and you'll find a little treasure trove - the Second Chance Boutique by Turning Point. Second Chance is a high-end thrift store that provides quality new and second-hand clothing for men, women and children, toys, home décor, furniture and more to the public and to clients of Turning Point Domestic Violence Shelter of Union County. All net proceeds from the public sale of items benefit the shelter, which is one of the largest in North Carolina with 42 beds.



The Second Chance Boutique opened in Waxhaw in November 2011 with three primary goals: 1) to take care of Turning Point clients, 2) to educate the public about the shelter, and 3) to provide funding for the shelter. A noble cause indeed. Last year alone 122 women and 147 children walked through the shelter's doors. Families receive meals, career and personal counseling, GED assistance if needed, and the children still attend school. Clients come from all over Union County and the shelter accepts overflow from Mecklenburg, Stanley and Anson counties. There is no set timeframe for how long a family can stay at the shelter. According to Judi Abbott, Director of Store Operations, the number one priority is to provide a safe haven until they are ready to make a break from their abuser. "It takes leaving an average five to seven times before that point of readiness happens," says Judi. "Each case is different, so don't judge. Domestic violence spans all occupations, all socio-economic status, all gender, and all races." Yes, there are some men who are victims of domestic violence, though they are not housed at the shelter but receive out of shelter services, counseling and hotel stays from Turning Point.

Second Chance also helps with Turning Point's mission to educate the public about domestic violence. The Boutique is an outreach store providing a face for domestic violence in the community. The boutique also assists with shelter funding. The Waxhaw location is the second of two stores. The first store opened on old Charlotte Road in Monroe in November 2009 with the Waxhaw location following two years later. The boutique provided \$68,000 in revenue to Turning Point in the second year of operation, plus provided funds for an expansion for the Monroe store. The goal this year is \$80,000 in revenue between the two stores. Future goals include opening stores in other parts of Union County and starting an Ebay storefront. The business is currently being coached by David Feldman, ADVI Coach, to provide the best possible outcomes for Turning Point.

Second Chance is open Monday through Saturday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tax-deductible donations are accepted at the store from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Pick-up of large items and large quantities of donations can also be scheduled. Your unwanted items will help out a most noble endeavor. Call them today.

# Designer Consigner Celebrates Grand Reopening

It's a quaint brick building housing several office suites and easy to overlook as it sits between BB&T bank and Blue Ribbon Realty/Waxhaw Information Center. But, women who want to find a little something for their wardrobe but don't want to go too far to search for the item, should consider seeking out the Designer Consigner store that anchors the building's main floor. The upscale women's consignment store opened in July 2011. Owner Lisa Giovanniello decided to open the store because she felt there was a need for good quality clothing close to home.



Julie Brewer, who came on board as store manager in December 2011, says customers have been saying it has been good to find this kind of quality in a consignment shop. "They also say they stop here first before heading out of town to shop at the mall or shops in Charlotte," said Julie, "so in that respect, the shop has also kept business in Waxhaw," she says. Faye Reule also assists in the store part-time and helped get the store up and running.

Designer Consigner carries Michael Kors, Ann Taylor, Cache and the like on the high end and very selective articles from Target and Old Navy on the low end with a little bit of everything in between. In addition, Lisa travels to America's Mart in Atlanta and brings back one-of-a-kind European designer clothing, shoes, and accessory samples from designer exhibitors at the trade shows there.



If you are interested in bringing clothes in for consignment, here is what you need to know. Bring your clothes in before 3 p.m. The staff will go through your clothes while you wait. They will put the clothes they think will sell out on the sales floor and give you back the "no thank yous." The staff prices the clothes based on what they feel the market will bear. Thanks to recently installed computerized consignment software, each consigner receives their own unique ID number which makes tracking inventory and sales much easier. Clothes are consigned for 90 days. You make 40% of what the item sells for which can be received as a check or as an in-store credit. If the item is still in the store after 60 days, it is marked down half price. If the clothes are still there after 90 days, there is a donation option or you can take the clothes back home with you. Clothes are donated by Designer Consigner to two places -

Rescue Mission and Crisis Ministry in Monroe. Right now, Designer Consigner is accepting spring and summer clothes. They will start taking Fall clothes in July.

Store hours are Monday through Saturday 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. For more information call 704-243-2109.





## Free Vision Screenings April 28 in Food Lion Parking Lot

The Waxhaw Lions Club and the North Carolina Lions Foundation will offer free vision screenings for visual acuity, cataracts and glaucoma on Saturday, April 28, 2012 from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. at the Food Lion parking lot, 1301 N. Broome Street in Waxhaw.

The North Carolina Lions Foundation's Vision Van travels across North Carolina conducting vision screenings. The van is staffed with volunteers and there is no charge to have your eyes screened. The screening can be the first line in the detection of vision problems.

Known for working to end preventable blindness, Lions participate in a vast variety of projects important to their communities. Locally, the most recognizable fundraiser is likely the Christmas tree sale during the holiday season on South Providence Street next to CVS. Additional local projects include providing free eye glasses and eye exams to people who cannot afford them, collecting recycled eye glasses, building wheel chair ramps, distributing Christmas food baskets to needy people, hosting a Christmas Party for the VIPs (Visually Impaired Person), and selling brooms made by VIPs.

The Lions have been involved in clinical eye research for years. The Lions have partnered with the North Carolina Lions Clinical Eye Research Center at Bowman Gray and the North Carolina Lions Pediatric Eye Care Center at Duke Medical Center. More than \$1 million dollars has been raised by Lions in support of these projects.

Because diabetes is the leading cause of blindness in Americans, convenience of eye care is paramount. Early detection of eye disease can have a significant impact on prevention of blindness. It is estimated that more than 230 million people have diabetes. This number is expected to rise to a staggering 350 million by 2025. People with diabetes are at risk of losing sight due to diabetic retinopathy.




