A Message from the Town Manager



Each year, the Board of Commissioners works to develop annual goals for the Town of Waxhaw. The Town Board began developing annual goals in 2007 to help drive the budget process. They are developed by the Board as a result of their interactions with you and your fellow citizens, feedback and recommendations from the staff, as well as other influences.

We have been fairly successful in meeting many of our goals, but like personal goals, some we hit, some we miss, and some take longer to complete. Several years ago, the Board adopted four broad goals which address just about all aspects of the community and town governance. Under each goal are a number of sub goals. Having looked at many organizational goals, I feel ours are second to none. With our fiscal year half complete, I would like to use this month's column to give you a progress report.

Goal: Create a well-planned and balanced community which provides residential, commercial and economic development and will provide adequate infrastructure, transportation corridors and options to access all parts of Town.

The Town is currently undertaking an effort to update its Comprehensive Plan. The current plan was approved in 2007 and it is the Board's desire to update the plan every five years. This is a good Board policy as the Comprehensive Plan is the big picture view of how the town should grow and develop, and should remain current. Zoning decisions are also made in consideration of the town's adopted plan. If you are interested in serving on this committee, we are currently accepting applications. The Board is also considering approving a contract with the Lawrence Group to develop a small area plan in the downtown area in conjunction with construction of a new Town Hall. In addition, the Board is considering approving a contract with Creech and Associates for the design of these municipal facilities. This could bring the best of both worlds together as each firm has their unique strengths and are looking forward to working together.

As a side note, we have also relit all of our downtown buildings with new low energy lights and they look great.

Goal: Promote Waxhaw as a Quality and Attractive Place to live and visit and recreate, promoting its history, antiques and arts while recognizing that new developments will occur and balancing the old and new Waxhaw.

We have spent a great deal of time working with Land Design in the creation of the Town's Parks and Recreation Master Plan. Under the guidance of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee, there have been three community meetings and several other public presentations. It is anticipated that the plan will be presented to the Town Board for formal approval in January.

We are continuing to work towards acquiring the Waxhaw water tank. Since being built in the 1940's the water tank has been a prominent part of our downtown. In the 1980's the tank was conveyed to the County along with its water and sewer utilities. We expect the tank to be back in Town ownership by the end of the year. The next phase of the project will be to clean up the tank and look at a beautification park in the area.

Improvements continue to be made to David G. Barnes Park and the H.C. Nesbit Park. In the H.C. Nesbit Park, we have paved the entrance road, improved the parking lot and done some landscaping in the area.

The Beautification Committee is working on the 12 Days of Christmas with wreath hangings, window decorations and other festive projects. Recently the Town, in partnership with the Beautification Committee and local artist Tom Risser, dedicated its first piece of public art. This art piece represents the placement of art under the Town's public art policy. The Committee is working to create a community art plan to help craft a vision for the future.

Goal: Provide quality public safety services which include police, fire, EMS and emergency preparedness and are delivered by well-trained and coordinated personnel utilizing modern equipment and techniques.

We are continuing to focus on community safety. Our police department has increased the number of foot patrols in the downtown and in the parks. In addition, we are working with the county on the regional emergency management plan and to ensure that we are in compliance with the required emergency training for both staff and the Board.

Goal: Good Governance

One aspect of good governance is an on-going dialogue between the town government and the citizens it serves. As Town Manager, I embrace that our job is to serve the citizens in a professional manner and with quality services that follow modern practices. This has been a consistent goal of mine, and the staff and I regularly hear from citizens who have noticed and appreciate the improved services. We are not perfect however, and always welcome suggestions on how we can be better.

In the spring of 2012, we will roll out our first Citizen's Academy. Citizen's Academy is an effective way to assist citizens in better understanding their government. In the meantime, I have been working with the Land of the Waxhaw's in streaming and recording a brief internet broadcast on local government topics involving Waxhaw. We are working to convert those videos to the Town's website which is www.waxhaw.com.

Also in 2012 we will roll out a new website that will contain more information and provide better features for citizen interaction. The website continues to be a primary vessel for acquiring information. We are also finding, as other studies confirm, that a person's first opinion of a town is formed when they look at the town's website. It is important that we put our best foot forward.

We also continue to improve our technology resources in an ongoing effort to improve our productivity, accountability and reduction on printing.

Your Town Board members continue to be involved in a number of regional and state efforts including organizations such as the Mecklenburg Union Metropolitan Planning Organization (MUMPO), the Centralina Council of Government and the N.C. League of Municipalities.

As we conclude 2011, I want to thank you for being a part of our community, and most importantly, your involvement. There is a place for everyone who wishes to get involved from serving as a volunteer at our events, to serving on a committee, or participating in a community meeting. It is your community, you help shape the future.

In closing, I want to wish you and yours a safe Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year!

2012 Facade Improvement Program


The facade improvement program is a grant program funded through the Town's annual budget to assist downtown property owners and businesses with improvements to the exterior of non-residential properties.






