A Message from the Town Manager



Your town government has undertaken a lot of initiatives designed to help plan for the future and provide opportunities for our citizens while preserving our historic heritage. This month I wanted to give you a report on some of these initiatives.

Waxhaw Water Tank – Recently we officially took ownership of the Waxhaw Water Tank. This 49,000 tank served the town from the 1940's through the 1980's. In the 1980's the Town merged its water and sewer services and assets to Union County. Several years ago the Board of Commissioners agreed that the water tank was an important part of the town's history and began working toward reacquiring the tank to begin preservation efforts. Within the next few weeks I plan to seek Board authorization to bid out the painting and repair of the tank, and our hope is to have the tank painted sometime this summer.

Old Police Department – Located at 209 West South Main Street at the David G. Barnes Park, the old police department has served the town since the 1920s. The building has served a variety of uses including a town hall/police department, health department, tee shirt shop and hot dog stand. Several years ago, this building came within one vote of being demolished. Since that time the town has worked to address a number of issues with the building. The exterior looks great with its historically accurate colors recently added, and in a few days we will start the interior renovation. Our plans are to completely gut the interior main floor and reconstruct a meeting area along with a unisex restroom and kitchenette. The building will then become a small community meeting center available for public use. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee will be making recommendations on the use of the facility.

Parks and Recreation Master Plan – This plan has been submitted to consultants for final revisions. In May, the plan is expected to be submitted to the Board of Commissioners for final approval.

Pedestrian Plan – This plan is being created to focus our efforts on where to improve pedestrian access throughout town and will work in conjunction with the Parks and Recreation plan. Like the Parks and Recreation plan, the final revisions are being completed and should be sent to the Board of Commissioners by June.

Branding Study – For well over a year a small group of citizens have been working with the Town to create an official brand. Many of you attended a charrette in the summer of 2010 where you gave your ideas on what the town meant to you. Taking those ideas, this group has worked hard to capture them in a logo that would represent the town. As you might imagine this has been a time consuming and challenging task. The committee is expected to present a final logo to the Board this summer.

As we begin to place closure on these projects I want to thank you for any involvement that you may have had, as it helps to ensure our success. Heroes Buried in Waxhaw

Southside Cemetery



Each year, for Memorial Day and Veterans Day, members of American Legion Post 208 and the Public Services Department of the Town of Waxhaw meet to place flags on the graves of Waxhaw veterans at Southside Cemetery. There are currently 158 buried heroes that fought in the Civil War, WWI, WWII, the Korean War, and Vietnam. They served in the Army, Navy, Marines, Air Force, Coast Guard and the Confederate Army. The rich history of Waxhaw knows no bounds and is a point of pride, especially with regard to military service. Below is a summary of what is currently known about our deceased Waxhaw vets.

- Civil War Veterans = 2
- WWI = 12
- WWII = 70
- Korean War = 9
- Vietnam = 3
- Cold War/Peace Time/Unknown = 62
- Killed in Action (KIA) = 3

Small Town Main Street Program Unveils New Logo for Waxhaw

The STMS Design Committee helped host a design charette in Sept of 2010, with the goal of creating a logo for Waxhaw to communicate the brand of our downtown marketplace. This mark would be used on all marketing materials promoting downtown and potentially on town government materials such as stationary and business cards. It would even be placed on town vehicles and downtown way finding signage, for consistency. Waxhaw residents, business owners, and professionals from the region's design community came out to voluntarily assist in the design charette process and after 3 days we had several concepts and potential themes for a brand mark.



Working with a committee can be a lengthy and challenging process. Our committee, with permission of Waxhaw's Board of Commissioners, consulted with a marketing firm to develop a tag line and finalize the graphic so that it communicates the brand message we defined during our 3 day charette session in Sept of 2010.

Our final logo graphic with interchangeable tag lines was approved by the Waxhaw Board of Commissioners and unveiled at SpringFest on May 12, 2012. The STMS Promotions Committee designed t-shirts, magnets, and key chains with the new logo which are available at Town Hall and at select

business locations downtown. Design guidelines which show the logo in various formats and defines the use of the logo as we apply it to stationary, vehicle decals, advertising, event posters, and promotional merchandise has now been drafted.

The Design Committee's next goal will be to work on a comprehensive way finding system for downtown, which will consist of a series of signs to direct pedestrian and vehicular traffic through our downtown. It is great timing that our way-finding project coincides with the Downtown Small Area planning process. As the downtown small area plan will define patterns of traffic and opportunities for infill development and infrastructure improvements, we will be creating a family of sign types that will be strategically placed downtown to navigate visitors and help them find a place to park. The signs will be designed so they communicate our brand by being consistent in color and materials and will be embellished with our new logo mark.



Rescue Dog Safe after Escape

A Community Thank You Message from The Waxhaw Animal Hospital

We at Waxhaw Animal Hospital wish to thank all of those who helped with a large effort to retrieve an escaped rescue dog on Wednesday, April 18th. This dog had just undergone a spay surgery the day prior to bolting away from her leash walk. She was obviously scared and not well-socialized to come to people, and so she continued running away from anyone approaching. She did stay in Waxhaw, and made attempts to come back to the hospital, only to run away again when spotted. Our entire staff spent the day trying various techniques to get the dog back while tracking her through town. Because of this, I personally want to thank all of our neighbors and community members who helped in the endeavor, including owners of several area businesses who not only allowed us to trespass and camp out on their property, but also went out of their way to help corral her. Thank you to all of the people on the streets, some of them walking their own dogs, but also following her travels, as well as all of the drivers who slowed when she would cross the street, or had to deal with our slow moving vehicles patrolling the area. I also want to thank Officer Holly Thomas, our Waxhaw Animal Control officer and her colleagues from Union County who spent their time trying to retrieve the dog as well. Officer Thomas' willingness to help track this dog speaks to her concern for animal safety. Finally, I would like to say that I am incredibly proud of the entire staff of Waxhaw Animal Hospital. Every staff member on duty was involved in trying to capture this dog, and they really went above and beyond in trying to retrieve her, some of them tracking her the entire day, and the rest hiking all around town in the rain that afternoon. The depth that all of these wonderful people care about animals is really unparalleled, and was very apparent on this day.

We do take the care of pets very seriously at Waxhaw Animal Hospital. For the thousands of dogs that are walked here every year, this is a situation that has never happened. We feel very badly, and above all were very concerned for the well-being of the newly rescued and frightened dog. We also thought that this would be a good opportunity to share this information with everyone in the community to say that even the best of us may face a situation where our pet has temporarily escaped. We have helped clients over the years whose dogs have gotten loose from them with collars or slip leads that are either too loose or malfunction in some way. Yet others, like what occurred with this dog, can be startled and overpower their owners. This is why it is so important to take as many precautions as possible to keep our pets safe. Here are some easy steps that can be taken today: 1) make sure that the collar fits appropriately, or consider using a harness for walking; 2) use a leash that is not too long and has a good grip for added security; 3) be aware of distractions that may scare your pet, including people, other animals, unusual surroundings & traffic; and 4) have your pet micro-chipped for identification if they do become lost. Please visit facebook.com/waxhawanimalhospital for more information about these measures. I would like to assure all of our clients and the community that we will continue to take special precautions for leash-walking rescue

dogs whose behavior is not well to eliminate the chance of this ever happening ever again.

Fortunately, the rescue group, Carolina PAWS, was finally able to trap the dog by 5:30 the next morning, and she is now recuperating at a foster home. Again, we want to thank our staff, neighbors, community business owners, Laura & Susan from CPAWS, and all other people in the community who helped with this special situation. Over 200 participants were in attendance to honor the fallen heroes of our nation on Monday, May 28th, in front of the Military Wall of Honor on East North Main Street. The ceremony itself was the result of a collaborative effort between the American Legion Post 208 and the Town of Waxhaw who succeeded in providing participants with a very personal, community-focused, and educational experience.



The ceremony began with opening remarks from the emcee, Town Commissioner Joyce Blythe, who welcomed the crowd while marking the significance of the day. Highlights of the ceremony included the Changing of the Colors by the Post 208 Color Guard led by Color Guard Captain Wallace Higgins, singing of the National Anthem by Ms. Rachel Sawhook, 3 Round Volley Salute as well as an Invocation and Benediction provided by Post 208 Chaplain William Reule Sr. Participants were inspired by the day's guest speaker, Town Commissioner and United States Marine Corps veteran, Sean Poccia who provided a hard-hitting perspective on the magnitude of sacrifices made by our fallen military personnel. Commissioner Poccia was later presented with a folded American flag by the Post 208 Commander James Grainger who also addressed the crowd. In perhaps the most moving part of the ceremony, two time Purple Heart recipient and Korean War veteran, Mr. Billy Watts, honored everyone by accepting the invitation to place a memorial wreath in front of the Military Wall of Honor. Mr. Watts was accompanied by Private Stephen Sutton of the North Carolina Army National Guard. Private Sutton is scheduled to deploy to Afghanistan this summer and honored the crowd with his participation as well. Mayor Daune Gardner was in attendance and imparted final remarks centered around taking the message of "remembrance" past the day itself. New enhancements to this year's ceremony included a POW/MIA Remembrance Table as well as an effort to educate the public regarding the symbolism of the military traditions they were witnessing. The Post 208 Ladies Auxiliary was on hand, after proper remembrances were rendered, to serve a light lunch provided by Subway of Waxhaw, courtesy of the Town of Waxhaw and American Legion Post 208.
