A Message from the Town Manager



As I craft this article on a cold November evening, I am amazed at how fast the year has gone by. Every year I say that, but this year I truly feel the weight of my words. I like to use at least one of my monthly articles to give you a progress report on what your town government has been doing. Whether you are a resident or business, you are an investor in our community and you deserve an accountability of what we have been doing with your money.

I have organized our accomplishments into several categories:

Planning for the Future

This year we were successful in completing our Parks and Recreation Master Plan. This plan set the goals for fifteen years and addresses the need for additional trails, parks etc.

We were successful in conducting a small area plan for our downtown. This plan allows for Waxhaw to implement steps to ensure a vibrant downtown. Our downtown is unique and a major draw for this part of the county and increasingly to surrounding communities. It is important that we keep it healthy. Related to this project is a change in our zoning code to a form-based code and a review of our sign ordinance. Both efforts should help provide flexibility in development while maintaining the Waxhaw image and vision. Additional small area plans are be forthcoming in 2013.

Infrastructure

A major part of community is its infrastructure. Infrastructure includes streets, sidewalks, parks and town facilities. During the year we acquired approximately 10 acres of open space in our downtown. Known as the Horton Property this property is located behind the David G. Barnes Park on Givens Street and will provide us great opportunities for passive recreation.

We successfully installed additional sidewalks through our Safe Routes to School program. Grant funding is covering most of the cost of this important project. Sidewalks are being installed in the Hillcrest community along Waxhaw-Old Monroe Road and near Kensington Elementary. It was nice to hear reports of residents who are excited about getting long awaited sidewalks in their neighborhood. Neighbors are getting out and speaking with their fellow neighbors. That's a community.

An underground storm water camera was purchased so we can begin to video stormwater drain pipes as part of our infrastructure acceptance program. The stormwater pipes are installed under the street before the street is paved. If the pipes are not installed properly the street will eventually fail and could cave in. Our objective is to make sure all pipes are properly installed before accepting new streets into the town. The developer pays the town for this service. We have already had several occasions where the pipes were improperly installed and had to be repaired. Thousands of dollars of potential repairs has been avoided for the town.

An architect has been hired to assist the Town in a space needs study and develop concepts for a new Town Hall and new police department. The facilities are vital to allow us to continue to provide top quality services to our citizens.

The old police department located at 209 South West Main Street at the David G. Barnes Park is currently being renovated. When completed the building will be used for a small meeting facility. The building is approx-

Two Arrests Made in Neighborhood Vehicle Break-ins

Waxhaw Police investigators arrested two Waxhaw teens for breaking into cars in the Millbridge and Quellin communities that occurred during the early morning hours of November 10. Nicholas Joseph Tahan, age 17, of 8005 Battersea Ct was charged on November 14 with 6 counts of breaking into cars, 5 counts of misdemeanor larceny and one count of Felony larceny from those vehicles. Also charged was Austin Robert Pelletier, age 18, of 3213 Blackburn Dr. in Waxhaw. Pelletier was charged on November 15th with 7 felony counts of breaking into vehicles, 6 counts of misdemeanor larceny and 1 felony count of larceny. Property taken from the cars included money, GPS units, a laptop and other property. Some property has been recovered. All of the vehicles were unlocked at the time of the larcenies. The investigation is ongoing at this time.

90 years old and has served the town as a Town Hall/Police Department, Police Department, Health Department, Hot Dog stand, tee-shirt business etc. Several years ago the building survived being torn down by one vote. We have painted the exterior of the building in historically accurate colors, while the interior work includes gutting the interior and adding a new bathroom, storage area, kitchenette and hard wood floors.

Another historic symbol that has served the town for many years is the water tower. We recently signed a contract to have it restored and repainted and plan to use it to implement free wi-fi in our downtown.

Technology

Our technology enhancements have allowed us to improve productivity and accountability at less cost. We recently implemented Sharepoint, a central repository for documents that improves the capability of departments and the Board to communicate and be aware of various developments. We are using cloud-based technology and are one of the few communities which use Sharepoint.

Another cloud-based application is with the implementation of our EnerGov permitting system. This software ties our building permitting process, business licenses and other information into one data source. EnerGov is a well-respected software used by many communities, particularly in the southeast. We outgrew our previous system and EnerGov provides the features needed to serve the public into the future.

A new website will be forthcoming in December. CivcPlus was contracted, and for the past nine months staff has been carefully reviewing and offering input for the initial design and providing information to support the site. Our new site promises to be more interactive, and citizens should see an improvement in the amount and ability to obtain information.

Workplace Safety

Waxhaw continues to strive to maintain workplace safety, an important component of our work environment. This year we received a Gold Award from the NC Secretary of Labor. The Waxhaw Police Department recently achieved the OSHA SHARP Public Sector Award. The OSHA SHARP Public Sector designation is awarded to employers with a consistent low injury and illness rate, have a strong safety program and the commitment of management to address safety concerns in the most effective way possible. This designation is new to the Public Sector. Previously, only Private Sector employers could qualify for the program.

As you can see we have been pretty busy. We constantly strive to be conscientious with your tax dollars and continue to seek ways to provide the highest level of customer service. But we know we could not have done it without you. As always, my door is open to meet and you can email me at mmclaurin@waxhaw.com.



This tour will feature six homes, as well as three historic buildings providing the "tourist" with a potpourri of history, rusticity, and uniquely created artwork. Until December 6th, individual tickets can be purchased for \$15 each at the following shops on Main Street in Waxhaw: Bella Dimora, 105 West South Main, The Bead Merchants, 102 East South Main, and Eight Legs Gallery, 310 East South Main. Tickets will cost \$20 on the days of the event, at the Waxhaw Woman's Club building, where you will receive the map of the tour, enjoy some light refreshments, and get the opportunity to learn more about what the Waxhaw Woman's Club does.



Eargle Home: Upon stepping across the threshold of this exquisite home built in the 1880's, you will immediately understand why it was chosen for the tour. The entrance just exudes love, not just for Waxhaw and its history, but also for its beautiful design and tasteful decor. The holiday decorations and trimmings make one feel he's amidst a Christmas wonderland.

Risser Gardens: As you stroll through the gardens at the Risser home, you become enthralled with the magnificence of the sculptured metal creations. Wherever your eyes take you, a unique sculpture seems to suddenly be in your scope of vision! It is almost magical. You will be viewing artwork as you have never seen before. Each piece of sculpture will provide you with one delightful surprise after another.



The Homestead at the Museum of the Waxhaws: A visit to the Museum of the Waxhaws provides you with a step back in time, which is what a historical museum should do. In the main building you will discover volumes of information about the 7th President of the United States, Andrew Jackson, a native of the Waxhaw region. In addition, you will uncover the culture of the Native American early settlers, as well as the Scots-Irish settlers, and the Civil War by viewing the historical costumes of these times and their way of life. The buildings on the grounds of this historical museum demonstrate the type of dwelling in which these new settlers lived. Reenactments of these historic times will be available for view.







Just for a moment, imagine an emergency at your home. You have to hurry out the door, leaving everything behind - your coat, your purse, your keys. And yet, somehow, you'll have to survive on your own. Scary, isn't it?

Because North Carolina has a poor record of protecting women from domestic abuse, this is a scenario that plays out often. That is why Turning Point domestic violence shelter has, for 26 years, provided a safe haven to such victims. Because, sometimes, bad things can happen to good people.

Turning Point serves over 500 victims every year from Union, Mecklenburg, and Anson Counties. The shelter offers 42 beds along with meals and program support for these women and their children. The goal is always to help them build a safe, non-violent life.

Turning Point operates two upscale resale stores to support its mission. They're called Second Chance Boutique by Turning Point. Victims are given, at no charge, clothing and house wares from the stores to help them rebuild their lives. The stores are also open to the public. 



Leaf Vacuuming Program
Will continue through Friday, February 1, 2013

The town is divided into two zones for service. Areas north of the railroad tracks will be vacuumed on Mondays and Tuesdays each week. Areas south of the railroad tracks will be serviced on Wednesdays and Thursdays.

In order to have your leaves vacuumed, they must be raked to the edge of the street. Please avoid placing them in the ditches if possible as this leads to storm drain blockage. Piles should consist of leaves only—limbs, rocks and other items damage vacuum machines and equipment. If these items are noticed in your piles of leaves, they will not be vacuumed!. Residents should avoid, if at all possible, parking in cul-de-sacs and on the piles of leaves where leaves have been placed curbside for vacuuming. Our equipment cannot access piles when parked vehicles are in the way.


