A Message from the Town Manager



Small Town Main Street Conference

Recently, I along with Commissioner Brett Diller, Gay Diller, Jane Hunt, Jody Sitton, Lori Oakley, Lisa Hoffman and Natalie Jackson attended the North Carolina Main Street Conference in Salisbury, NC. Located about 40 miles north of Charlotte on I-85, Salisbury is an excellent model of a successful downtown.

North Carolina is a nationally recognized leader in its Main Street program. The successful template, modeled after the National Main Street Program, works to stimulate economic development within the context of historic preservation, using a four-point approach which includes: organization, promotion, design, and economic restructuring.

One of the conference highlights was a presentation on the elements of good community development by North Carolina Commerce Secretary Sharon Decker. These elements are: 1) access to good health care; 2) good quality education; 3) economic development particularly in the area of small business development; 4) promotion of arts, culture, and tourism, and 5) good quality of life.

While she spoke I found myself doing a mental checklist on how Waxhaw compared to her list. I have been fortunate to witness many of the items on her list expand and come to fruition in Waxhaw. There are now more health care opportunities in Waxhaw through the investment by Novant and CMC-Waxhaw. Each of these organizations has a prominent presence in our town and participates in our town's activities.

The Union County school system continues to be one of the top rated in the state. There are also a number of quality private schools to choose from in the area.

In economic development, the town provides top quality public services for the tax dollar spent thus ensuring that we have a safe and attractive community. We will meet with prospective business investors and walk them through the process of opening or expanding a business here in Waxhaw. We coordinate grand openings and offer a business listing on the town's website. Currently, we are also working on some more formal avenues for economic development to help guide the future growth of our community including the development of area development plans, a park and recreation plan, a comprehensive pedestrian plan, and a revised sign ordinance and zoning regulations

In the promotion of arts, culture and tourism, we have increased our investment in our Events Division to expand the number, size and offering of our events. Our investment has also included downtown beautification including additional Christmas lights during the holidays, benches, and plantings. We are currently in the process of developing a community public art plan and are seeking your input.

A large group of individuals assist the town in our Small Town Main Street Program including Jim Black of the Land of the Waxhaws group, the Waxhaw Business Association members, merchants, non-profit organizations, and volunteers. The results have been successful with our First Friday events continuing to keep our downtown buzzing on Friday evenings. If you have not been to one of our First Friday events, please plan to join us at the next event on March 1st beginning around 5:00 p.m.

All of these items add up to the last item on Secretary Decker's list, that is good quality of life. We are working hard to make Waxhaw a town in which you can be proud. Thanks for working with us and being a part of our community. We are glad you have chosen to call Waxhaw home.

The tour is also open to the public. If you plan to attend, wear comfortable shoes and expect to walk about a mile over the course of an hour-long exposition of Waxhaw history.



Waxhaw is First Police Department in North Carolina to Receive OSHA SHARP Public Sector Recognition

The Waxhaw Police Department is the first Police Department in the state to achieve recognition as an OSHA SHARP Public Sector employer. The SHARP (Safety & Health Achievement Recognition Program) designation is awarded to Public Sector employers who are successful in protecting employees from death, injury and illness by implementing comprehensive and effective safety and health programs. In addition, the Department must also achieve a rate of injuries and illnesses that is equal to or less than the three year average across the state for the particular entity. The NC SHARP Public Sector Award will be presented to Chief Michael Eiss by Cherie Berry, NC Labor Commissioner, at the Waxhaw Town of Commissioner's Board Meeting on March 12, 2013 at 6:00pm.



In other safety and health news, The Town of Waxhaw employees will once again be receiving a Gold Award from the NC Department of Labor recognizing their efforts toward injury and illness prevention in all Departments.



Waxhaw's Public Service staff received notification from the National Wildlife Federation in late February that the Dare Steele Memorial Garden has been deemed a Certified Wildlife Habitat. The garden, located at the intersection of McKibben, Belk and South Providence streets was completed in 2008.

Tony Helms led the certification endeavor. According to Tony, "all of the requirements are there for birds to flourish in the city. Mature trees add a nice lookout and abundant roses allow birds to build nests in the dense briars. There are also blue bird houses and a bird bath so that water is readily available for them. The food is provided from the many species of insects that the roses attract as well as several blueberry bushes."

Please join us in congratulating Tony Helms and the Waxhaw Public Services staff on this achievement and for the great job they do in maintaining our parks, gardens and downtown.



Waxhaw Recertified As Tree City USA

The North Carolina Forest Service has recertified Waxhaw as a Tree City USA for the fourth year. The Tree City USA program recognize cities for their excellence in urban forestry management. Communities achieve Tree City USA status by meeting four core standards of sound urban forestry management: 1) maintaining a tree board or department, 2) having a community tree ordinance, 3) spending at least \$2 per capita on urban forestry and 4) celebrating Arbor Day.



US Flag Flying High Again





White Oak of Waxhaw: Skilled long-term care with the latest design

Many of us believe that nursing homes are cold, sterile, institutional places. Oftentimes, the words conjure up sad and scary images of abuse and neglect or feelings of shame and guilt among family no longer able to care for their aging loved ones or embarrassment by residents unable to care for themselves anymore. However, there is a recent movement to change the culture of nursing homes and rethink how care is provided. Care is becoming more individualized and the facilities look less like an institution and more like a home. The objective is to provide care within the rhythm of a resident's life when they need it and less on a regimented schedule. And you'll find such a concept right here in Waxhaw at White Oak of Waxhaw.



White Oak of Waxhaw, built in March 2010, is a 100-bed skilled nursing facility with 4 "neighborhoods." Each of the 4 corners of the facility is a neighborhood. There are three long-term and one short-term neighborhoods with private and semi-private rooms with 27 people living in these neighborhoods. There are accommodations for married couples. The families in these neighborhoods do activities together, hang out together, and get to know each other. Each neighborhood has a common living room, dining room, kitchen, even a salon, spa and social services office.

In fact, it reminded me a lot of my college dormitory years, albeit in a much cleaner environment. All the rooms have a private bath, and private shower. Residents can decorate their own room to personalize it including favorite artwork, pieces of furniture and personal belongings. The guiding principle



of staff at White Oak, according to Director of Admissions Katrina Potter, is that "this is their home and we are here helping them in their home. We get to know the families of our residents. Everyone is really close here."



The facility also has a state-of-the art rehabilitation center offering up to 3 hours per day of individualized therapy. Outpatient therapy is also available. Colleen McGee, Manager of the Rehab Center, explained that the center has state-of-the art therapeutic equipment and much of it used by the Carolina Panthers football players in their

own rehab facility. On-site therapists can use equipment such as the Omnicycle for neurological, orthopedic and cardio pulmonary rehab, the Omnistim FX2 Pro multi-modality electrical stimulation system to assist with the treatment of disuse atrophy, muscle



reduction and strengthening and pain management applications, and the Omnisound therapeutic ultrasound system for treatment of knee osteoarthritis. In addition, the Biodex Balance helps seniors regain their natural mobility and improve their balance and stability. A mock kitchen and bathroom setting in the center also help therapists retrain patients on the use of these facilities after debilitating strokes.

Cathy Parris, Director of Nursing for White Oak of Waxhaw, commented that what distinguishes White Oak from so many other places is not only the level of care provided but also the emphasis on person-centered, family-centered care.

One Registered Nurse (RN) supervisor is on duty 24/7 in comparison to most other facilities which only have LPNs. In addition, each neighborhood has one RN or LPN and three CNAs on duty 24/7 first and second shift. The overnight shift even offers one LPN or RN per two neighborhoods and two CNAs per neighborhood so critical care is always available.

Ms. Parris reiterated the philosophy I heard Katrina say earlier, “We are a guest in our residents’ homes and have to be the kind of guest that will be invited back each day. Our staff gets very close to the residents and personally grieve when a resident is lost.” There is also medical staff on site Monday through Friday and on call 24/7. A physician is on site Monday and Thursday, a physician’s assistant Thursday and Friday, and a nurse practitioner Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Residents are seen every 60 days and more as needed. A podiatrist, eye doctor and dentist also visit White Oak regularly.

To assist with the homey feeling of the facility, much like at a hotel, one will never see the inner workings of the staff - the kitchen facilities, the laundry facilities, housekeeping, maintenance are tucked away in the middle corridor of the facility. Administrator Renita Chapman shared that 150 part- and full-time employees in the nursing, dietary, laundry services, housekeeping services, life enrichment, maintenance and social services fields work at the facility. Yet when walking around White Oak, one primarily sees the residents in their rooms or out mingling with other residents in the common areas. They are definitely the primary focus of the facility and everything revolves around their exceptional care.

Anyone interested in volunteering at White Oak is encouraged to call Katrina Potter at 704-243-7640. Volunteers are always needed in the Life Enrichment Area directed by Tracey Esser. One-on-one visits to read, give manicures, deliver mail, and just visit with residents are always appreciated and help provide the personal caring touch to the residents. Setup, decorating, and cleanup for events during Halloween trick or treating, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Easter, summer picnics and cook outs, wine and cheese parties, and group outings are needed. Show a senior in your area that you care about their contribution to our world while they are still here.

Chronotek: High Tech Firm Finds Home In Waxhaw

Right under our noses in historic downtown Waxhaw sits a high-tech firm that few in the community probably know exists. It is the charm and historic character of Waxhaw that attracted the firm to call this area home. Originally founded in 1996, Chronotek bought their location in Waxhaw last fall. Brandon Fox, owner of the company, lives with his family in Waxhaw and decided to bring his business here as well.

Chronotek bills themselves as “your leading telephone timekeeping experts.” They offer quite an innovative service to their clientele and I was intrigued by the ingenuity. Employers can see live clock-in data 24/7, from any internet connected device, a business owner can see who is clocked in, where they are, and the time they arrived. The owner also receives “no-show” text alerts and can send out a must-listen voice message to his or her employees, which they will hear before being able to clock in. Employees simply call a toll-free number using their location’s phone when they arrive at work. If for some reason the employee doesn’t call in, the system sends a text message to their supervisor. When finished with the job, the employee calls the same toll-free number to clock out. Calls can be taken from landline phones, or cell phones where GPS tracking is enabled.



The system was originally developed for the janitorial cleaning industry, but now many other industries with remote employees use it to capture accurate time as well. The technology even has applicability to industries as an attendance tracker. Retail and offices can track when a store is actually opened by an employee. In addition, the system automatically calculates the employee timesheets, which saves the business owner time in calculating the time cards himself. The technology easily integrates with Paychex, QuickBooks, ADP and Paycom. Fox calculates that for every \$1 a business spends on the solution, they will save \$4 on payroll.

Chronotek employees have the option to work remotely, and for this reason Fox says company meetings are a necessity. Working remotely makes it difficult for employees to understand the company culture, or for the culture to fully develop. The office and meetings help everyone connect with each other on a regular basis, giving everyone a sense of place and understanding of their role in achieving the company’s overall goals.




