Ordinance Amending Recreational Vehicles and Trailers

WHEREAS, in pursuance of authority conferred by G.S. 160A-174 and 160A-175 and for the purpose of protecting the health, safety or welfare of the people in the Town of Waxhaw, the Waxhaw Board of Commissioners has determined to amend certain provisions of its ordinance regulating commercial vehicles downtown; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Waxhaw Board of Commissioners of the Town of Waxhaw, North Carolina that:


Chapter 71.03 (3)(f) is revised in its entirety and replaced as follows:

71.03 (3)

- (f) Recreational vehicles, trailers and boats stored on trailers shall not be parked or stored on any public right-of-way within the Town. Exceptions to this requirement include parking on any public right-of-way for the duration necessary to load or unload such vehicle as may be necessary for its intended use, provided that such loading and unloading shall not exceed twelve (12) hours in one interval.


**Effective Date:** This ordinance shall be effective on the 1<sup>st</sup> Day of September, 2018.
