

On Tuesday, August 13, 2024, the Board of Commissioners conducted a regularly scheduled business meeting.

The regular meeting began with the following recognitions:

- Ryan Springs was recognized for his 20 years of service with the Town of Waxhaw and honored with a service award.
- The Waxhaw Lions Club was recognized for their donation to the Parks and Recreation Department for a Communication Board.

The Board of Commissioners approved the following:

- Approval for Union County Tax Office to be charged with the collection of Fiscal Year 2024-25 Tax Bills.
- Adoption of Ordinance (ORD2024021) Amending Declared Temporary Road Closures for Events.
- Adoption of Ordinance (ORD2024022) to Accept a Donation from the Waxhaw Lions Club for a Communication Board.

The Board of Commissioners conducted the following Public Hearing:

- For Text Amendment TA-016-2024 – An Amendment to add R2 Single-Family Residential Zoning District and Conservation Development Design Standards to the Land Development Code.

During the leadership report, Town Manager Wells provided the following updates:
