

On Tuesday, March 12, 2024, the Board of Commissioners conducted a regularly scheduled business meeting.

The regular meeting began with the recognitions honoring Officer KC Jennings with the Officer of the Year and the DWI Awards. Also, Detective Patrick Helms was honored with the Top Gun Award.

The Board of Commissioners approved the following:

- Adopted the BOC Meeting Minutes for
 - January 25 and 26, 2024 – Retreat Meetings
 - February 13, 2024 – Regular Meeting
- Adopted Resolution (RES2024007) for West North Main Street from NC 16 to Rehobeth Road into the Town's Street System.
- Adopted Resolution (RES2024008) for South Providence Street from NC 75 to McCain Street into the Town's Street System.
- Approved the Town's participation for the 2025 Urban Archery Season.
- Adopted Text Amendment TA-13-2024 for Smoke and Tobacco Shops

The Board of Commissioners received an update on the Waxhaw Master Transportation Plan community engagement.

The Board of Commissioners discussed the revisions of the BOC Rules of Procedure and will provide feedback to staff at a future meeting. The BOC also discussed and provided feedback related to the 2x2 meetings. The BOC agreed to continue with the 2x2 meetings and directed staff to publish the Meeting Outcomes.
